Love Through Worship

*“I trust in your unfailing love; my heart
rejoices in your salvation.”*

Psalm 13:5

In all of my roles as a mom, teaching my children about God is the one I take most seriously. They know that I love them with all of my heart and that I do my best to love them unconditionally. But I want them to know that God loves them even more—after all, He IS love (see 1 John 4:8)! So whenever I’ve made a mistake or a child comes to me with an apology, I say, “God loves us NO MATTER WHAT! How awesome is that?” I want my children to learn from my example that God loves us even though He knows us completely!

Try This:

Have each family member think of a motion for the words “trust,” “love” and “rejoices.” Repeat the verse together, and when you say those words, each person also adds the motion created for the word. Afterward, brainstorm to think of the most praise-filled song to God that your family knows, and sing it to Him to thank God for His unending love.
