Getting It Right

“Do what is right and good.”
Deuteronomy 6:18

When the kids are out of sorts and I’m exhausted, I look for ways to break the mood and help us all “do what is right and good.” If we’re in a checkout line, I might say, **See that little boy with his mom? Let’s pray for them. Jesus, please go with that boy and help him have fun with his mom.** Then I look for a simple way to have fun with my kids, too, like singing on the way home, or blowing bubbles or playing with play dough when we get home.

Try This:

My kids sometimes get frustrated when they can’t do something they want. And they don’t always choose the best way to express it. **I might say, I feel that way sometimes, too, when I can’t do what I want. Then I think about something fun I did get to do today.**
