Loving Families

*Jesus said, "A new command I give you: Love one another.
As I have loved you, so you must love one another."*

John 13:34.

I began when my kids were very little to teach them to express their love to others. I looked for opportunities when they could say thank you to people who took care of them. You have your home family and your church family and maybe a daycare family, too. Give your toddler a way to say "I love you" to family. Take a walk outside and collect nature items. Help your child glue them onto a paper folded in half to make a card. Glue a picture of your child to the card and add the words "I love you." Make a card for each of your child's teachers and caregivers.

Try This:

Hold your hands to your eyes like binoculars. Look around the room. Describe what you see. **I see a red chair. I see a green plant.** Look at your child and say, **I see you! I love you!**
