Yet you know the pitfalls they face in trying to be accepted, and their potential for making choices to please others rather than God. We try to keep the lines of communication open with our kids so they can learn from our wisdom about making choices. At mealtime, we take turns sharing about people at work or school who are popular or successful and what wise choices they have made that makes them that way.

Try This:

To model conversations with God for my child, I sometimes pray out loud at bedtime, asking God to help me know what's right and wrong and asking for His help as I make choices that will please Him.
