In All Your Ways

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.”

Proverbs 3:5

Has your family ever faced a job loss, a sudden death in the family or something else that has made you wonder, Wow! Where is God taking us? Such events can make us scramble to lean on our own understanding—and can make our children feel very insecure! But these are also good times to use this week’s Bible verse. We can reassure our kids that even though we don’t always know or understand what God’s plans are for us, that’s OK. He wants us to trust in Him during these times. Talk with your family about God’s character (He is loving, wise, knows everything, etc.). Focus on reminding yourselves that He is working according to His good plan for your family. He does all things well!

Try This:

Whenever you hear of a family member or friend who is in some sort of difficulty, gather as a family. Brainstorm what ways you will show your support for that person. If the person is local, bring a meal or plan a get-together. If the person is farther away, send handmade cards or a care package. Decorate a note on which you’ve written this week’s Bible verse, and make sure to let your friend or family member know you are praying about the situation.
