Wisdom, Please!

“If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.”

James 1:5

Some questions my kids ask are ones I can't respond to immediately! Either I don't know the answer or I need time to figure out how to answer in a way they can understand. Whenever I say to one of them, "Give me some time to answer that," I write the question on a Post-it Note to remind myself. And there have been many times I have had to take their questions to God for wisdom in answering them! When we revisit the question, I tell them how it prompted me to pray so that they know it's powerful and important to pray about everything. It also teaches them that not every answer has to be immediate!

Try This:

Decorate the outside of a jar or other container with this week's Bible verse. Keep paper and pencil in the jar so that family members can write down situations they struggle with or questions they want to ask God. During family prayer time, read these aloud. Ask God to grant each of you the wisdom you need in those situations.
