## Your Child's Sense of Security

*"I rejoiced with those who said to me,  
'Let us go to the house of the Lord.'"*

Psalm 122:1

As new parents, we want our precious kids to feel safe and loved. I look for ways to help my child develop a sense of security by talking with him about God's love when we play together. I say, **God loves you. God made your hands so you can build with blocks! God loves you every day. I love you, too!** If your child is part of a church nursery, talk about the loving people at church. **The people at our church love you!**

### Try This:

Our church has been like a second family for our kids! When they were babies, to help them feel secure and comfortable at church, we came up with a "good-bye ritual" of a hug, a kiss and a wave good-bye. Then we made a quick exit, even if our child cried. Tears are normal—and prolonged departures often make matters worse.
