## Exploring God's World

My kids always liked repeated prayers that they can learn and say. Even when my kids were tiny, every time we'd eat we say this short prayer together: **God, we thank You for this food, for rest and home and all things good, for wind and rain and sun above, but most of all for those we love.** As they grew older, they started chiming in on the words. Saying this prayer built a habit of thanking God for the way He provides for us. (Start saying it today and use it for Thanksgiving dinner with all the relatives!)
