## Who Is Taking Care of My Kids?

***“I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me . . . . I lay down my life for the sheep”***

John 10:14-15

We can't be with our growing kids every minute! But when I can't be with my kids, I can trust Jesus, the Good Shepherd, to be with them, guiding and protecting them. To remind us all that He never leaves them alone, I might put up a sticky note at the door that says as they are leaving for school, "Follow the Good Shepherd today. He'll lead you in good paths." In the evening, I try to share the ways I saw God leading me during the day and ask them to tell about ways they noticed God's leading during their day, too!

### Try This:

I do my best to use my texting for good! I send a text during the day to one of my kids just to say, "I love you" or "I am proud of the choices you're making." Sometimes I'll send an inspiring thought or a Bible verse, just to encourage them. When I see them acting in loving ways, I remind them that they are imitating Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who cares for us all.
