People Helpers

*“I will be with you; I will never
leave you nor forsake you”*

Joshua 1:5

As we drive through town, I point out places and people that help my kids become familiar with our community helpers—the fire station, the hospital, the dentist. When we drive by our church, I repeat the name of our church and say, **People at church help us.** When we meet police officers, firefighters, health workers around town or during appointments, I point to their name badges, tell my toddler who each one is and then how that person helps others. It not only teaches my little one about our community but also teaches respect for community helpers!

Try This:

At home, it's fun for your toddler to have a few band-aids and other supplies so she can play doctor and put band-aids on other people. I name the body parts she puts them on or ask her what body part it is. We pretend to be firefighters, using a garden hose to put out fires—or gardeners, watering plants! When we read together, I remind her that Ms. Kristina reads books to her at church, too. **God gives us people to help us.**
