Pretending Together

***“He is the Rock, his works are perfect, and all his ways are just.
A faithful God who does no wrong, upright and just is he.”***

Deuteronomy 32:4

On a warm day, I put snacks or lunch in a bag and take my toddler outside. While we sit under a tree, I tell him Zacchaeus’ story. Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus, but he was too short (we put our hands down low). He couldn’t see over all the tall people (hands up high). So Zacchaeus climbed a tree (pretend to climb the tree). And Jesus saw him. He said, “Zacchaeus, come down. I want to go to YOUR house” (pretend to climb down). Jesus loved Zacchaeus (hug self). **Jesus loves you, too.**

Try This:

Play Let’s Pretend. I say, “Let’s pretend we’re frogs!” and we hop around until I name something else: “Let’s be monkeys.” Sometimes I will say “Let’s pretend . . .” and then pause to let my toddler fill in the animal we’ll imitate!
