Forever Love

See 2 Chronicles 6:14

I tied jingle bells onto my toddler’s shoelaces. He loves to walk, jump, or even lie on his back and kick his feet in the air, just to listen to the sound! The big plus? I know right where he is in the house! As he wanders, jingling, I tell him, **Jesus loves you in the kitchen. Jesus loves you in the playroom. Jesus loves you wherever you go.**

Try This:

For easy practice in listening and following directions, play the “Stop and Go” game. I stand at one end of the room and say, “Go” and my toddler starts walking towards me. When I hold up my hand and say, “Stop,” he stops. We play until he reaches me. Then I grab him, hug him tight and say, **I love you! Jesus loves you, too.** Next, it’s his turn to say, “Stop” and “Go” and I go to him. This is a great skill to learn—that way when you’re outside, he’s practiced stopping when you say, “Stop!”
