Sharing with Friends

Serve one another in love. The entire law is summed up in a single command: “Love your neighbor as yourself.”

Galatians 5: 13-14

At snack time, I set out bowls each holding a different kind of cereal, raisins and mini-marshmallows. I let my child choose a spoonful from each bowl to put into his own bowl. It's a simple choice that's appropriate for his age. When he's finished, we wash our hands, and fill snack bags with spoonfuls of those ingredients in any way he chooses. We call them Friendship Snacks. He gives them to his friends. I say, You are a kind friend. You shared your snacks.

Try This:

At bedtime, I read the story of Jonathan and David in my child's Bible Story Book. After we read about their friendship I said, **God gave you friends, too. Who are your friends?** We name his friends. With their moms' permission, I take pictures of his friends at church and print them out. That way, we can look at them and say their names.
