Life with Toddlers

John 3:15

I'm amazed at the life God has given us—both here and for eternity. I want my child to fully realize them both. As he's growing physically, I give him opportunities to be his best. To develop upper body muscles and provide a visual experience, I made yarn balls and hung them from the ceiling so my baby could bat them as he lay on his back. When he was older, I played rolling and throwing games with large light balls, working on getting the ball where we wanted it to go. When it was nice outside, we could throw or roll it as far as we could. In the nice weather, we made a place for digging in the sand with shovels so we could fill up pails and build and dump sand. I tell my child, God made you. **He made the air we breathe in—and out! He loves us!**

Try This:

Find a Toddler Bible Story book with lots of clear, understandable pictures and few words. Look at it regularly with your toddler. Point out items in the pictures, "Look at the birds!" or "See Jesus? He loves boys and girls." Ask questions like, "Can you find the flowers? How many rocks do you see? Let's count the rocks." The Bible will soon become your toddler's favorite book!
