Who Are You, Baby?

Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:22-23

It seems my toddler does something new every few days. I try to write down some of them down to read back later. It helps me remember how far she's come! In the morning I say, "Good morning! What's your name?" I'm teaching her to say her first and last name and other things she might need to answer. "How old are you?" I put up fingers so she can copy how old she is. "What's Mommy's/Daddy's name?" **I say, You are special to God. You are special to me. I love you.**

Try This:

For a fun way to have conversation, give her an old cell phone and ask her questions. She loves to ask me questions, too. Sometimes I don't understand her words, but it's fun to listen to the way she makes her voice sound like mine when I talk. We take turns, which teaches her another conversational skill—not interrupting! I tell her, I love you. She repeats it. I tell her **God loves you**. She repeats that back to me, too!
