God Cares for What He Made

*Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him.
He will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream.*

Jeremiah 17:7-8

One summer, we made it a habit to check the weather every day. Then we'd talk about our plans for the day. If it was raining, we looked at the drops on the window, listened to the thunder. Then we planned indoor activities. If it was sunny, we put on sunscreen and planned outside activities. We did Shadow Dancing, watching our shadows as we moved. I would say, **God made the rain and the sun. Plants need rain and sun. God cares for plants. God cares for you.**

Try This:

Did you know that up and down movements, like bouncing and jumping, help kids become more alert? Back and forth movements, like rocking in a chair or swinging have a calming effect. Good to keep in mind next time you need alert—or calm—babies!

Another way to calm a little one is with a quiet bath. It's also fun science! Notice and talk about the water as you move more slowly and calmly. Say, **God made water for us. He gave us water so we can get relaxed and ready for bed!**
