Help!

Love is patient, love is kind.

1 Corinthians 13:4

When my child is having a hard time being kind, sharing or being patient, I give her our private time-out sign. We move away from the area and ask God to help us. We take a moment to “breathe in—breathe out.” Then I look her in the eye and ask, “Ready to try again?” If not, we wait a moment. If so, off she goes. At bedtime we’re sure to say, “Thanks, God, for helping me today.” It took a few times of doing this until she understood what we were doing, but eventually she seemed relieved to have both my help and God’s in difficult situations!

Try This:

I play Look Out for Love with my preschooler. When we’re at the store, library, park or wherever, we’re on the lookout for love in action. When we see someone being kind, helpful or patient, we each try to be the first to say, **Love is patient. Love is kind.**
