Growing Toddlers

Habakkuk 3:18-19

While my toddler is with me and I'm folding clothes, we play a game: She finds all the socks and puts them in a pile. Then she finds the washcloths, etc. I also like to ask her questions: **What do you wear on your feet?** As I hold up a shirt or shorts, **What is this? Who wears these pants?** After she finds all the different items, I say, **Thank you. You are my good helper. I am glad God made you!**

Try This:

When I take my turn helping in the nursery or even when I look through the nursery window, I watch to see how the toddlers play and interact. I try to remember what toys and items are my child's favorites at church. That way, as we get ready for church the next week, I can remind him of all the things he likes to play with in the nursery. I want him to know that church is something to look forward to."
