## With a Little Help

*With love, help each other.*

See Galatians 5:13

When my son was a preschooler, one of his favorite sayings was, “I can’t do it!” He’s even recorded for all time on video saying it. (Many years later, we still imitate his words and tone of voice when something is hard!) My response when he was little was, “May I help you do it?” He would let me help but it was important that he had a part in doing the task, too. This helped him to gain more confidence in his ability to do things independently. **It’s OK to get help from others. God made us to work together and help each other.**
