The Greatest Family

Play with your kids often. It builds your relationship as you share in their world of play. Tell your kids how much you enjoy being a child of God and experiencing joy in what He has created. **Being part of God’s family is the best!** Some ways to play for a moment might include: When waiting at a restaurant, lay several items on the table. Let everyone look at them and then close their eyes. Take one away and see who can guess what is missing. When folding laundry, get your kids to help fold the small towels or match all the socks. And there’s nothing like a spontaneous sock fight! When you are outside on a sunny day, play shadow tag, trying to step on each other’s shadows.

Try This:

Take turns at mealtime or before bed listing the things you like best about your family. Write these down. Then ask each one to share something they’d like to do or change. Write these down, too. Look at the list. Notice the things that everyone likes and try to do more of these. If possible, add or change things that were mentioned. Tell your kids that families are very special and you want to make yours a safe, happy place for everyone in the family. (Some people make this a weekly ritual—a Saturday morning or Sunday evening “check in” meeting where everyone can contribute to making the family even better!)
