Love in the Family

Forgive each other.

See Colossians 3:13

You can't live together without having opportunities for forgiveness. I want my young children to learn early that they need to first be careful of the feelings of others, and then to make things right when they have been hurt. When a sibling breaks a toy, there is sadness or anger. Those are natural feelings. But I want my preschooler to know he controls his behaviors when he feels this way. Hitting or breaking things is not an option. After a time, I have my kids say, "Sorry," and "I forgive you."

Try This:

At bedtime, I pray with my preschooler, **"Thank You, God, for loving us. Help us show Your love by being kind and forgiving to others. In Jesus' name, amen."**
