Getting into God's Word

"Hear the word, accept it, and produce a crop."

Mark 4:20

I share with my kids, **My relationship with Jesus is not just words.** I tell them how important God's Word is to me, how it has changed me, and how it helps me get to know Jesus and follow Him. Sometimes I put a couple of questions up on the computer screen and a Bible verse or two. I ask everyone in the family to read the verses and input their answers. I use questions that my kids can use throughout their life when they read God's Word: **What do you learn about God or Jesus? and What do you learn about what you can do?**

Try This:

Getting preteens to open up is so important in knowing what makes them "tick." Use these conversation-starter questions when you're driving in the car or eating together: **What is your earliest memory? What are your three most favorite things to do? What two things do you dislike the most?** Their responses can help you know ways to guide and help them—and pray for them, too!
