Saying I'm Sorry

"You are kind and forgiving, O Lord."

See Psalm 86:5

When my children do something wrong, I correct them and have them say they are sorry. I also want them to learn to ask God for forgiveness. So I lead them in prayer and have them repeat after me: **Jesus, I'm sorry I hit Mallory. Thank You for forgiving me.** Then I hug my little one and say, **God is kind to us when we say we're sorry.**

Try This:

When my child expresses himself with misbehavior, I tell him it's better if he uses words or hand signs so I can help him. If he doesn't want to do something, he puts his hand up to indicate "stop." Then we can talk about why he doesn't want to, or why we need to, or how we can change things.
