Learning From Mistakes

“Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.”

Psalm 51:1,3

Have you ever wished you could just start something all over again and do things differently? Since we can't go back in time, the next best thing is to learn from the past and change for the better. In our family, we take seriously the Bible verse that says to hide God's Word in our heart so that we won't sin against Him (see Psalm 119:11). We choose a Bible command and talk about it with our kids at bedtime, mealtime, or car time. It reminds us how God wants us to live and keeps us accountable to each other.

Try This:

When my kids fail and are discouraged because of it, I tell them about a time when God helped me learn through my failure and become better.
