For Eternity

***“Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life.
He who believes in me will live, even though he dies.’”***

John 11:25

The other night we were watching TV as a family. One character in the story was talking about his commitment and said, “I’m in this for life.” It can be hard for kids to think about things they will do for an entire lifetime—they simply don’t have much context for that! But as we teach our children more about following Jesus, it’s important that we help them understand that our commitment to Him goes beyond even this life: We’re in this not only for life but also for eternity! After we grow old here on Earth and die, we will continue to live with Jesus in heaven forever!

Try This:

On a large sheet of paper, draw out a family time line. Mark important events (births, joining a new church, moving, etc.) that have already happened. Then invite family members to add things they hope will happen to your family in the future. Draw a circle near the end of the time line. Write, “Life in Heaven with Jesus.” Then ask everyone to write or draw something he or she expects to do with Jesus in heaven.
