Believing Without Seeing

*“Great is our Lord and mighty in power;
his understanding has no limit.”*

Psalm 147:5

So many people in our world today cannot accept God’s power and love for us, because they have never seen Him. As our children begin to share their faith with their friends, at some point they are going to encounter a child who asks, “Why do you believe that?” We try our best to prepare our children to answer such a question, but when the time comes, only they can answer. Just as we must trust in God’s power even when we cannot see Him, we must trust God to be present with our children and to help them when faced with this question.

Try This:

Write “oxygen,” “gravity,” “freedom” and “love” on separate index cards. Hold the cards facedown and invite your kids to each choose one. Talk about what makes you believe in each of these things. **Even though we can’t see these things, we believe in them because we see what they can do!** Then, write “God’s power” on an index card. Talk about what you see that makes you believe in God’s power.
