Getting to Know Your Child

How well do you know your toddler? What makes him smile and laugh? What keeps him busy for a long time? What frustrates him? Sometimes when my child doesn't listen, I get down to his level and make sure I have his attention. I've realized that when he's busy playing, it's not always that he is disobeying when I tell him to do something, it's that he's busy. As my child grows, I keep trying to get to know him better and ask God's help so I can love him better.

Try This:

To help my toddler learn to identify and understand the feelings of others in our family and to express his own feelings, I make exaggerated faces when I'm happy and when I'm sad. I ask, **Can you show me your happy face? What does your sad face look like?**
