Keeping Kids Busy

"I love you, O Lord."

Psalm 18:1

When I'm working in the kitchen, I keep my preschooler busy by putting corn syrup and red food coloring in a baggie. I zip and tape the top closed tight. She can finger paint without making a mess. I show her how to make a heart shape. I ask, **Who are the people we love?** We name those we love--family members and friends. And we say, **I love You, Jesus.**

Try This:

To keep young children occupied in the kitchen, I hang a large sheet of paper with magnets to the fridge door and let my child draw. I can glance at what she's doing, name the colors she's using, ask her to tell me about her picture, and enjoy time together while we're both busy with our jobs.
