



## GAME TIME!

Talk about the importance of forgiving others. Then gather the family outdoors and get out a jump rope or length of clothesline. Have family members take turns jumping the rope (adults too!). Count the number of successful jumps. For younger children, see how many times they can jump or step back and forth over a rope held a few inches off the ground. Thank God that He is willing to forgive us even more times than we can count.



## TOGETHER TIME!

Using a pencil, make a list of times when members of your family might need to forgive others, such as when others are mean to you, when people laugh at you, when a friend doesn't share, and so forth. Then, using small pieces of rye bread, take turns rubbing over the words to erase them! This fun experiment can remind family members that when we forgive others, we should also give up bad feelings about them. The bad things they have done are simply erased!
