Name things that can be powerful—water, fire, a storm, a muscular person, and so on. Write each powerful thing on a separate slip of paper. Play a game of power charades or draw pictures of the powerful things. Have one person choose a slip of paper and try to act out or draw the powerful thing named on the paper. The first person to guess correctly what is being acted out or drawn can choose the next slip of paper and continue the game. Emphasize that our powerful God created and is in control of all these things.
