Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Judges 2:8-15.
God is not pleased when we disobey. What happened to the Israelites when they disobeyed Him?
- **MONDAY**—Read Psalm 104:33, 34.
God deserves our praise! How can our family praise Him?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Romans 8:5-8.
What are we watching on TV? What kind of music do we listen to? Do you think our choices please God?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Colossians 3:20.
Do you think God is pleased with the way you obey your parents? Is there anything you need to change?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Hebrews 13:16.
What good thing can our family do for someone this week?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Genesis 5:23, 24; Hebrews 11:5, 6.
Do you think our time with God is pleasing to Him? How can we improve the time we spend with Him?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Colossians 1:10.
What kind of good work are we doing for God? Are we pleasing God in what we do?
