## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Hebrews 11:17-19.  
God asked Abraham to sacrifice his own son Isaac. Why was Abraham willing to do that?
- **MONDAY**—Read Hebrews 11:1-3, 6.  
What is faith? Why do we need faith?
- **TUESDAY**—Read James 2:14-18, 21-23.  
Faith is more than just believing in God and Jesus. What else is needed?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Luke 6:43-45.  
Do the things we listen to and watch at home tell our friends that we believe in God?
- **THURSDAY**—Read James 1:2-4.  
Sometimes our faith is given a test. Why do you think that happens?
- **FRIDAY**—Read 1 Peter 5:8, 9.  
How can we stand firm in our faith in God?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Hebrews 12:1, 2; Revelation 2:10.  
What will be our reward for faithfulness?
