Family Devotions

Hopefully your preteen is beginning to develop a habit of personal devotions. But there are still plenty of times when your input is needed—and valued. Encourage your child to read the daily Scriptures. Read the verses yourself. Use the questions to help your preteen understand the verses and apply them to life. Discover and learn from God’s Word—together!

- **SUNDAY**—Read 3 John 9-11.
Have you ever done something that might be considered evil? How did you feel? What good things can we do to make others want to be a part of the church?
- **MONDAY**—Read Romans 12:1, 2.
What do you think it means to give yourself as a sacrifice to God? How does Satan try to persuade us to follow worldly ways?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Luke 10:25-29.
What do these verses teach us about the Christian life? What good things happen when we give our lives to Jesus? Why does Satan try to keep us from loving Jesus?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Philippians 4:10-13.
What circumstances do you struggle with? How does God’s strength help us during hard times?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Ephesians 4:21-24.
Why is it a good thing to follow Jesus rather than the devil? What are some bad habits you are trying to break? What can we do to show others we are obeying Jesus?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Galatians 6:7-10.
Do any of your friends ever do things that mock God? What do some people do to please their “sinful nature”? When we make right choices and do good to others, how is God praised?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Philippians 2:14-16.
What does it mean to be blameless and pure? Why do we need to let our lights shine for Jesus? What “word of life” should we give to others?
