Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Titus 2:13, 14. Why did Jesus die for us? Does this make you feel eager to serve Him?
- MONDAY—Read Luke 23:20, 21, 26, 27. How did the women in the crowd respond when they realized Jesus was being led away to be crucified?
- TUESDAY—Read Matthew 28:5-9. How did the women at the tomb respond when they knew Jesus was alive?
- WEDNESDAY—Read Mark 16:9-11.
 Do you believe that Jesus rose from the dead?
 Why?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 Peter 1:3, 4. Why should we celebrate Jesus' resurrection?
- FRIDAY—Read Matthew 28:8-10. How can we worship Jesus today?
- SATURDAY—Read Ephesians 1:3, 7, 8.
 What are some ways God has lavished His blessings on our family?
