Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Proverbs 2:6-10.
Why is it so important for us to have wisdom?
- **MONDAY**—Read Proverbs 3:5, 6; 9:10.
Who is able to give us wisdom? What wise choices should we make?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Proverbs 13:20.
Why is it important to associate with people who make wise choices?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Proverbs 22:24, 25.
What does wisdom have to do with our having bad-tempered friends?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Proverbs 6:6-8.
What can we learn from the ant that will help to make us wise?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Proverbs 12:1; 13:1, 18.
Why is listening to parents and being disciplined good for us?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Luke 6:47-49.
To whom did Jesus compare the man who built his house on a rock foundation?
