- **SUNDAY**—Read Titus 1:1, 2.
To what does knowledge of the truth lead?
- **MONDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 4:7, 8.
What is the value of living a godly life?
- **TUESDAY**—Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10.
What should we be content to have? What is the danger of always wanting more money or things?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read 2 Timothy 2:22-24.
Have you ever had a stupid argument with someone? What did you argue about? Why should we be careful about arguing with others?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Colossians 4:5, 6; James 3:3-10.
Stick out your tongue. Why can such a small part of the body cause so much trouble?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Titus 2:11-14.
We should remember the phrase “Just say NO!” God can help us say NO to sin.
- **SATURDAY**—Read Colossians 3:12-14.
What attitudes does God want us to wear as part of our daily wardrobes?
