Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Psalm 145:13.
God is faithful. How can His faithfulness be an example to us?
- **MONDAY**—Read Hebrews 10:23.
Why can we be confident in holding onto the hope and trust we have in God?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Hebrews 11:32-34.
Many people are listed in these verses. What do we know about the faith they had in God? How did they demonstrate that faith?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Matthew 25:14-30.
God has given members of our family many blessings and talents. How can we use those gifts faithfully for Him?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17; Romans 12:12.
How do we show faithfulness to God by praying? When can we be faithful in prayer?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Matthew 26:14-16, 47-50, 69-75.
Some of Jesus' closest friends did not always stay faithful to Him. What can we do to stay faithful to God?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Revelation 2:10.
God wants us to be faithful to Him. He is waiting to give us a reward that is out of this world!
