

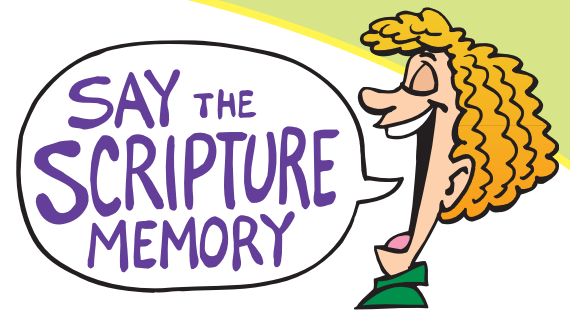
# Faith & Family

## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read 1 Peter 1:13.  
As a family, in what areas do we need to practice self-control this week?
- **MONDAY**—Read Ephesians 6:1-4.  
How can our family put these verses into practice on a daily basis?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Matthew 6:19-21.  
What are some material things our family has? How can we be sure these things are not more important to us than God?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Luke 6:27-36.  
We are to love everyone! What are two ways our family can show love to others this week?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Exodus 20:7; Leviticus 19:12.  
How might someone use God's or Jesus' name in a wrong way? Do you think others believe that we really love God if we misuse His name?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Matthew 28:19, 20; Mark 16:15.  
God doesn't want us to keep His love a secret. Who can we tell about God and Jesus?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Philippians 3:14.  
God has a prize ready for us if we obey Him and accept His salvation through Jesus. How can we be more obedient today?
