Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Acts 8:9-13; 9:10-19.
Ask a family member or a friend to tell you how he or she became a Christian.
- **MONDAY**—Read Romans 3:23; 6:23.
Who has sinned? Who can have God's gift of eternal life through Jesus?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Hebrews 11:1, 6.
When we have faith in God, what do we believe about Him?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Acts 2:38; Romans 6:4.
What do these verses teach about repentance and baptism?
- **THURSDAY**—Read 1 John 1:8-10.
Do you feel relieved when you admit to a wrong you have done? Why is it important to confess our sins to God?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Ephesians 4:29-32.
What negative actions do we need to stop doing? What positive actions should we be doing?
- **SATURDAY**—Read John 3:16.
God promises to give us the best gift we can ever get. What do we need to do to receive that gift?
