## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Hebrews 13:16.  
With whom can we share this week? What can we share?
- **MONDAY**—Read Matthew 5:43-48.  
It's not easy to love someone who picks on us or makes fun of us. What does Jesus say we should do about these people?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Matthew 7:1-5.  
What happens when we wrongly judge other people? What does Jesus mean when He says there is "a plank in your own eye"?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Matthew 6:25-34; Philippians 4:6, 7.  
What are some things we worry about? How important are those things?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Philippians 4:8, 9.  
What kinds of things should we think about?
- **FRIDAY**—Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-20.  
Each of us has different abilities and talents. How are the various members of our family using their talents and abilities to build up the church?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Acts 28:30, 31.  
As Christians, we are to tell others about Jesus. Who do we know who needs to hear about Him?
