GOD IS WORTHY! PARENT PAGE

JESUS HEALED A MAN BORN BLIND (tune: "London Bridge")

Jesus healed a man born blind. (Point to eyes.) Yes, He did! Yes, He did! (Show thumbs-up.) Jesus healed a man born blind. (Point to eyes.) Clap your hands and worship. (Clap.)

Praising God for who He is, (Point upward.) who He is, who He is. (Point upward.) Praising God for who He is. (Point upward.) Give a shout and worship! (Cup hands around mouth and shout, "Thank You, God!")

Ask your child to tell you the Bible story of how Jesus healed a man who was born blind, or read the story from John 9 in a Bible. Sing "Jesus Healed a Man" to the tune of "London Bridge."

Each day this week, find a way to worship God. You might pray to God on Monday, sing a song to God on Tuesday, clap your hands in praise on Wednesday, and so on. When you have worshiped God together, allow your child to color one of the stars on the page.

"GOD IS WORTHY" GAME Play a family game similar to I Spy. Say:

God is worthy. Yes, indeed! Look around and you will see. I see something that is _____. (Name the color of the item you have chosen.)

Let family members guess what object you see. When the object has been guessed, talk about how that item reminds you of God and His power. Continue the game, letting other family members choose an object to be guessed.

Remind your child: God is worthy of our worship. We can give God our love and praise and thanks.
